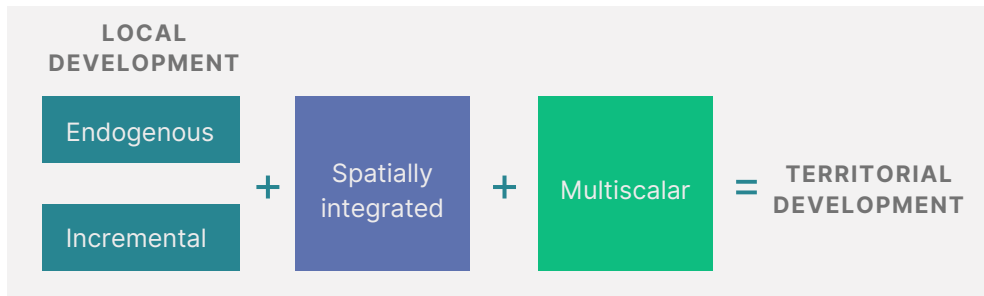
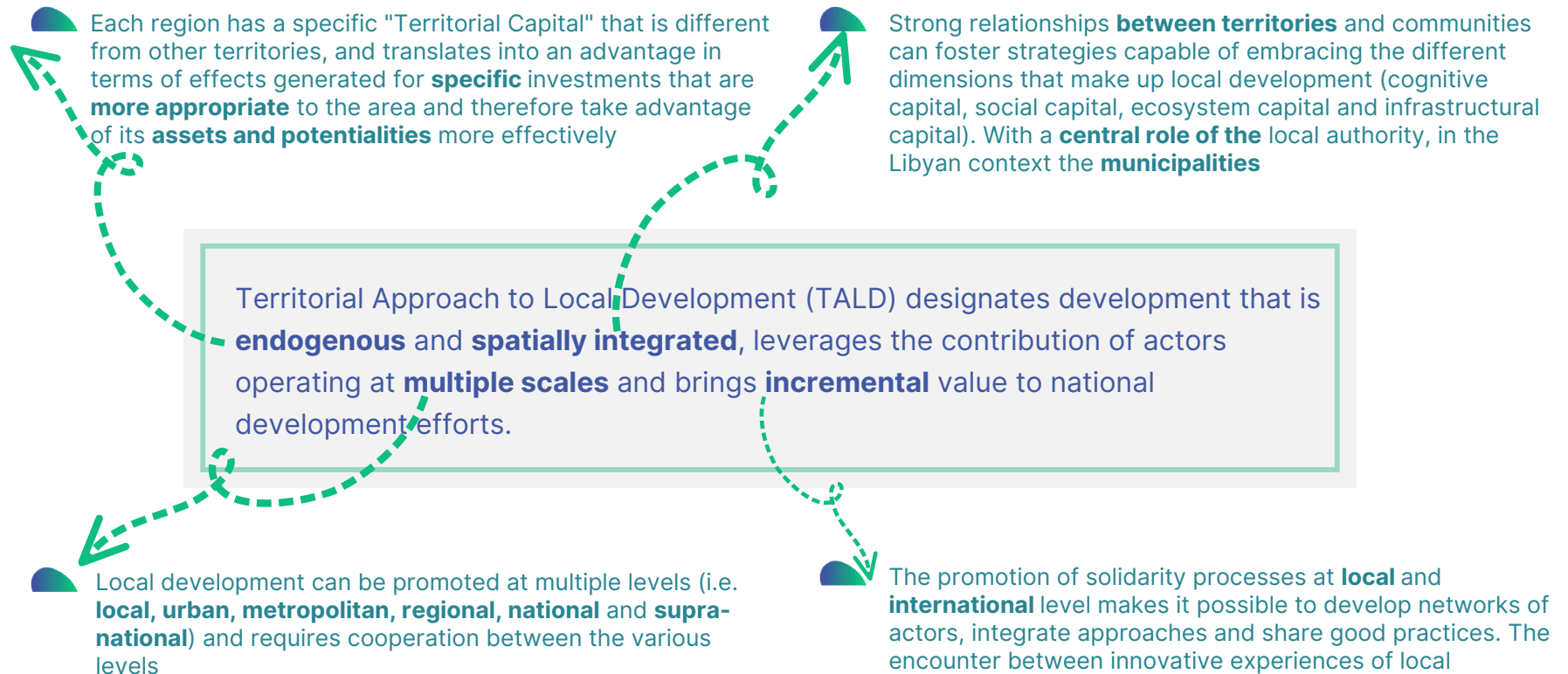

EVALUATION

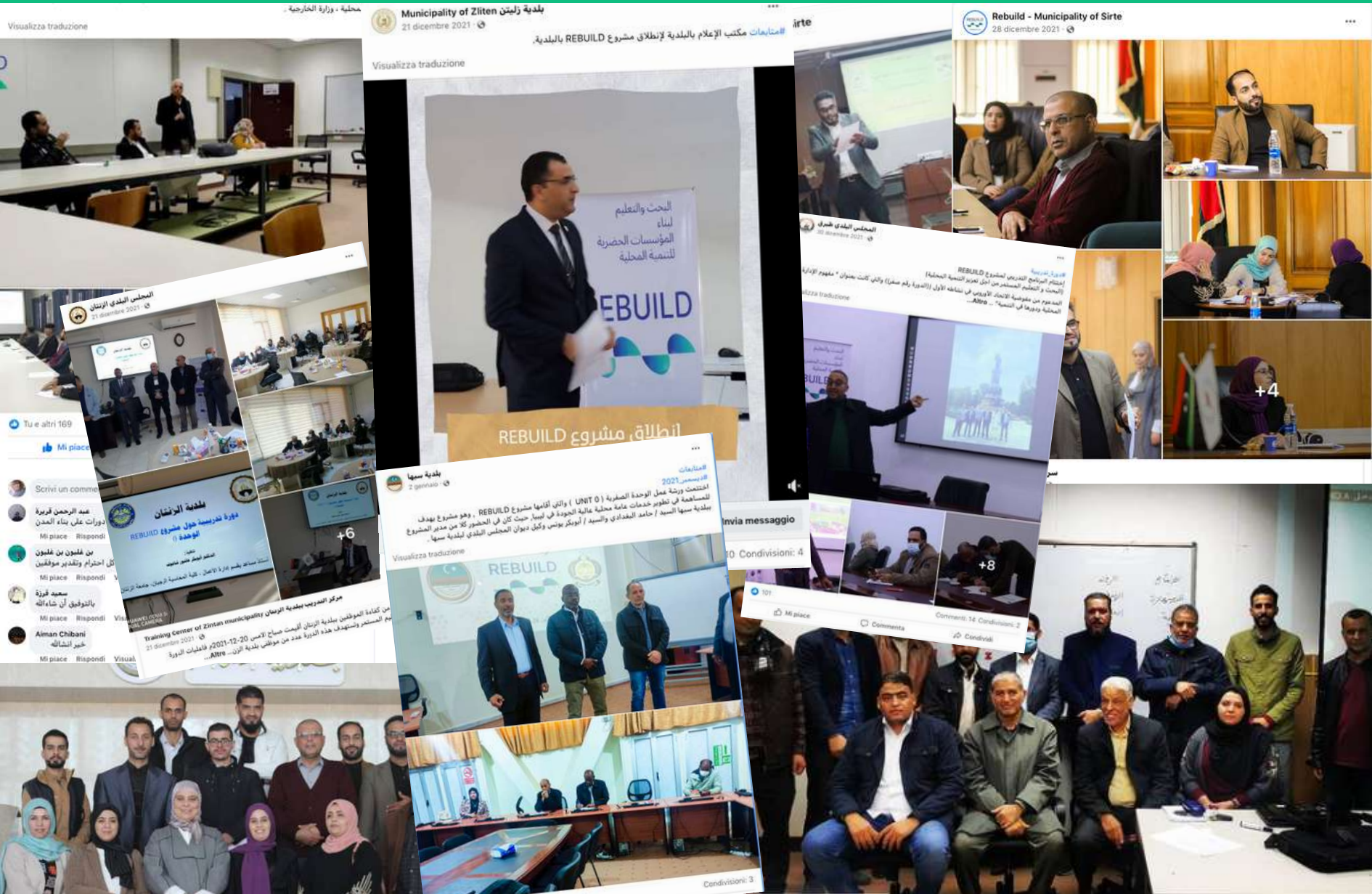
MODULE "0"
