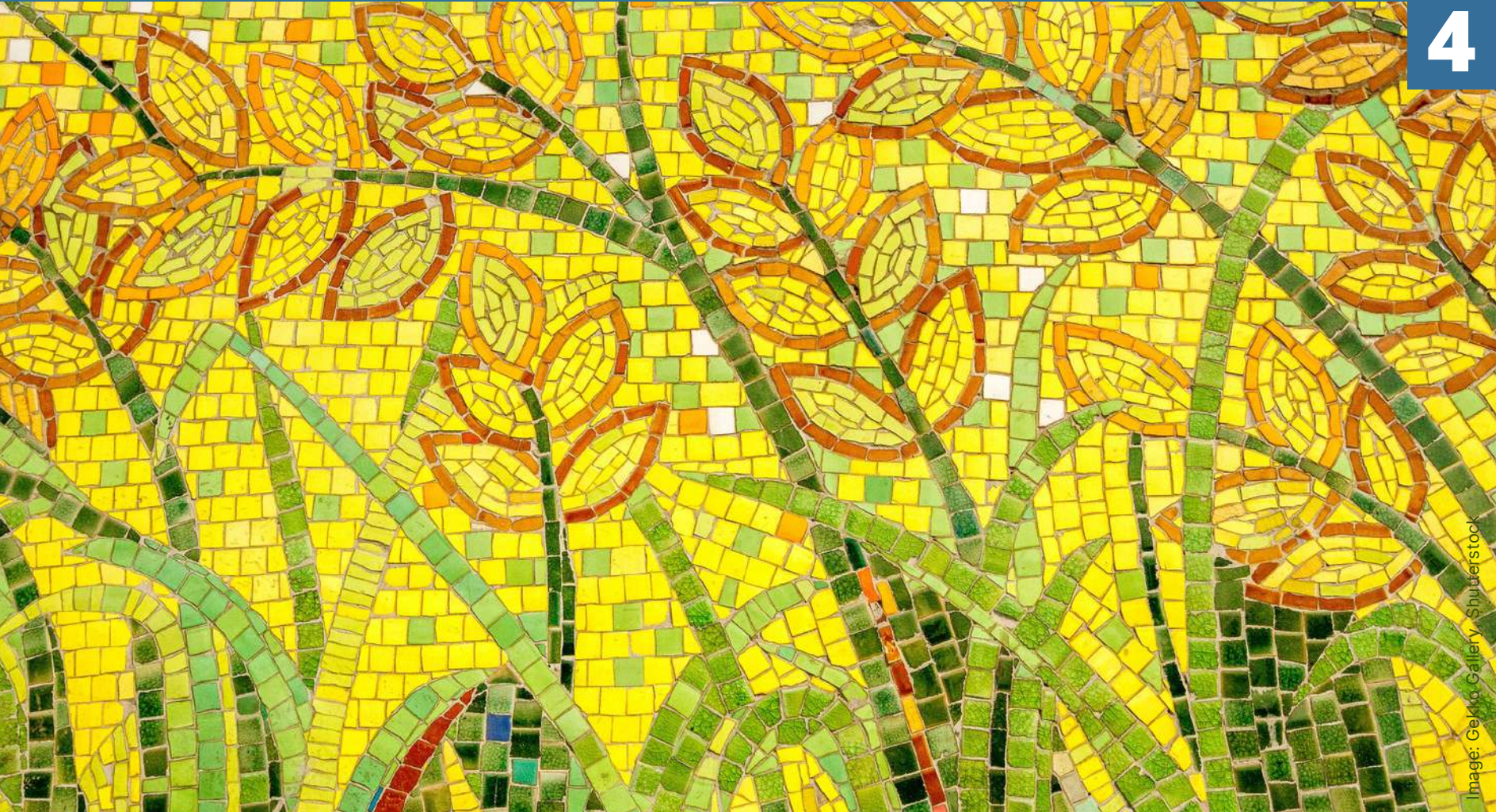


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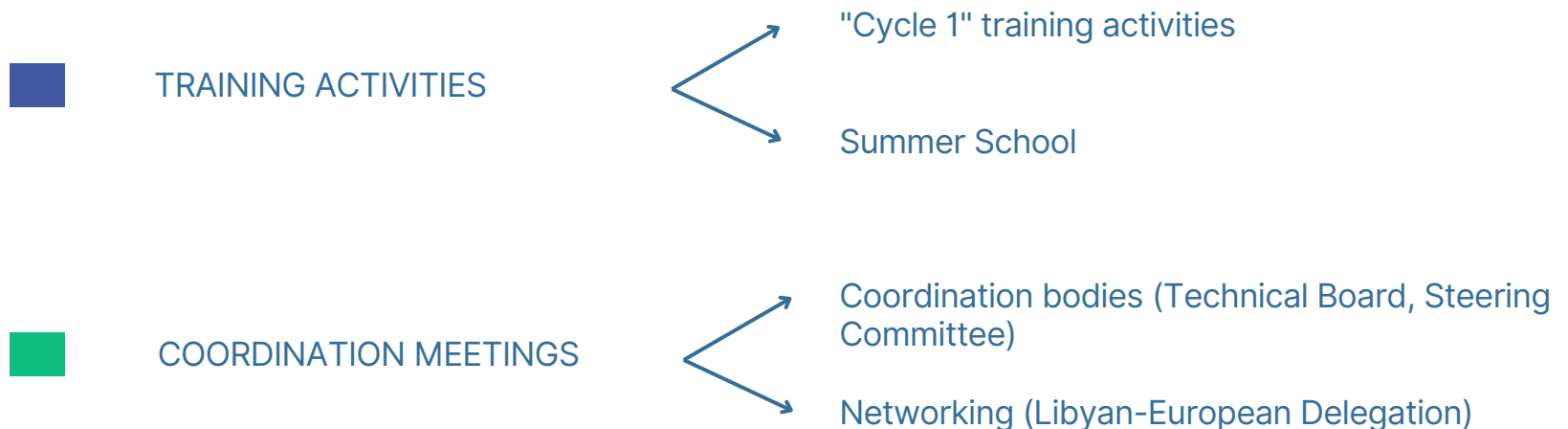


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# INTRODUCTION

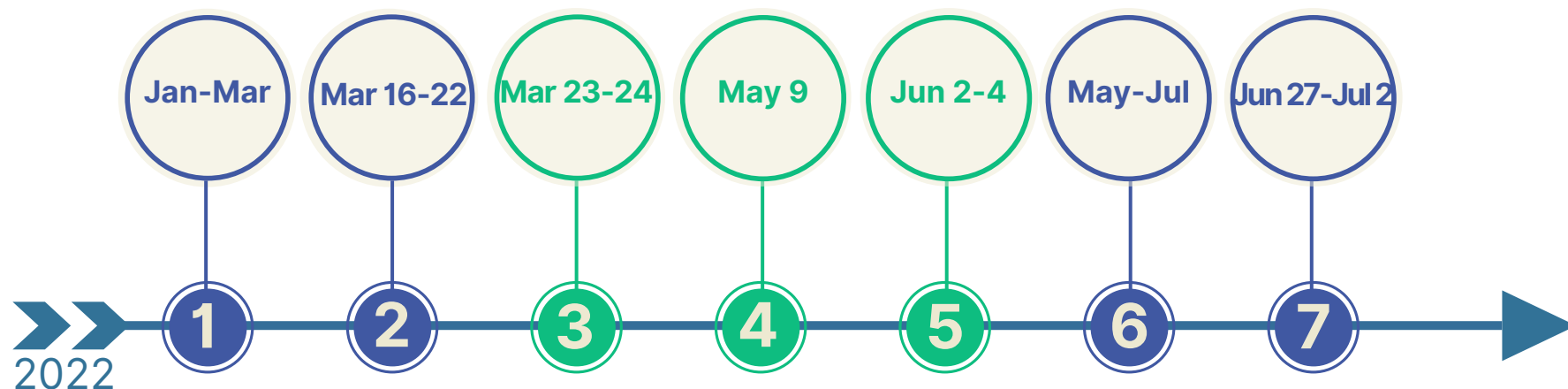

# CYCLE 1 TRAINING ACTIVITIES



The courses present the responsibilities of municipalities in leading local and sustainable development processes, the steps and tools of urban planning (vision, diagnosis, formulation of strategic goals and objectives, M&E), the linkages between local development and decentralisation.

By the end of the cycle, each participant should be able to:

- Understand the role of municipalities in local development processes
- Identify areas of action in which each participant's work can improve her/his municipality
- Master the decentralization process, its main features, opportunities and challenges in implementation
- Recognize the main elements to conduct a territorial diagnosis and identify priorities

# EVALUATION OF "CYCLE 1" ACTIVITIES IN LIBYA

## Relevance of contents and adaptation to the Libyan context

- + 93,5% agreed or strongly agreed that the trainer was able to adapt the training materials to the Libyan and Municipality contexts
- *As for the strategic planning course, I would have liked the course to focus more on the technical side, for example, the latest methods and programs used to collect data*

## Quality of pedagogy/methodology

- + 91,5% agreed or strongly agreed that the trainer used the appropriate training tools during the seminars to communicate information in a smooth and understandable manner.
- *Methodologies, in my opinion, need more time than this time so that the pressure of the trainer and the trainee does not occur*

## Implementation of New Skills

- + 85% agreed or strongly agreed that they will implement some of the elements discussed during the training into their professional activity in the Municipality.
- *I will implement some of the elements discussed, if the capabilities and resources needed will exist*

## Organization of the training

- + 85,5% agreed or strongly agreed that the Municipality Project staff have effectively supported the smooth organisation of the training activities.
- *Making training in summer months is difficult when there is no electricity because it is very hot*

## Expectations and general remarks

- + 87,5% agreed or strongly agreed that the overall training complied with their expectations at the beginning of the cycle
- *More advertising on the project by the municipality to citizens*

# SUMMER SCHOOL

## Local authorities and communities for local development in Libya



The Summer School was a **6-day intensive capacity building activity**. It was based on the assumption that **sharing experiences** among municipalities facilitates establishing a **community of practices** and represents the opportunity to strengthen the **internal and international networks of Libyan municipalities**.

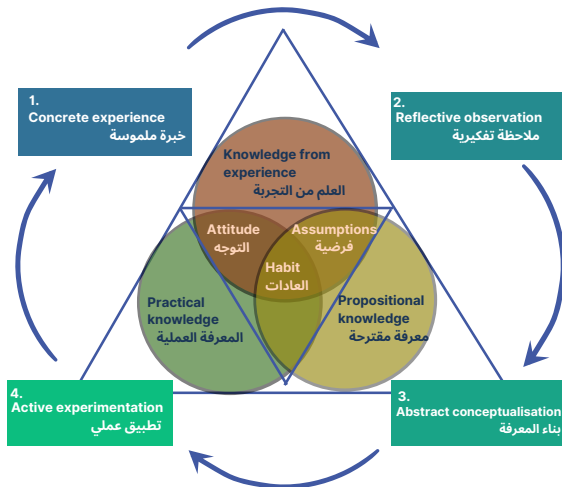
**Main topic** of the Summer School: local development and the role of municipalities.

**Specific contents:** local governance, waste management, territorial promotion/tourism, technological and social innovation.

**Methodology:** the Summer School was methodologically developed around the **Participatory Experiential Learning approach**, which refers to experience as a basis for learning, and to the interaction among participants as a means to generate mutual understanding and collective learning.

Each morning activities included field visits, exchanges of the experiences, meetings with local administrators.

Each afternoon activities included the analysis of the morning field visit, facilitated by a thematic expert, with the aim to establish a link between Trentino case study and participants' contexts (municipalities).
