INTRODUCTION

Local authorities and communities for local development in Libya

The Summer School was a 6-day intensive capacity building activity. It was based on the assumption that sharing experiences among municipalities facilitates establishing a community of practices and represents the opportunity to strengthen the internal and international networks of Libyan municipalities.



Objectives

- to inspire and promote the planning and implementation of local development actions and strategies in Libya, starting from the Trentino experiences
- to encourage the exchange of experiences between participants as a basis for a permanent dialogue on key local development issues



Methodology

The Summer School was methodologically developed around the Participatory Experiential Learning approach, which refers to experience as a basis for learning, and to the interaction among participants as a means to generate mutual understanding and collective learning.

Each morning activities included field visits, exchanges of the experiences, meetings with local administrators.

Each afternoon activities included the analysis of the morning field visit, facilitated by a thematic expert, with the aim to establish a link between Trentino case study and participants' contexts (municipalities).



Participants

20 Libyan municipality officials from 10 municipalities.

They included human resources and training experts, strategic planning and public service delivery managers.






How does training for municipal staff support better services to citizens?

The new training methods support the employees of the Municipalities providing services to citizens, give them the opportunity to see innovative experiences in other locations, to build and design new services to citizens.

Are there key roles and skills in which it is important to invest in training?

Especially for what is required to local authorities today, alongside technical skills, it is important to invest in new skills related to the ability to design, the ability to communicate, the ability to create a system

What is the added value of having a permanent body that oversees the aspects related to peace and human rights within the Provincial Council?

Trentino 30 years ago, in 1991, decided to set up a body that deals with peace and human rights on a daily basis, the Trentino Forum for Peace and Human Rights, based on the Provincial Council, a meeting point between civil society and institutions. Issues like peace and human rights should not be dealt with only when a conflict breaks out, but on a daily basis.

What advice about waste management to municipalities in a context like the Libyan one, where there isn't yet a separate collection or an adequate technical situation?

The first phase is planning the process, then identifying the key stages, with the creation of all the infrastructures necessary for the cycle and the design of a cultural approach to these changes in mentality and daily operations.

If a technical waste management can be organized within a year, what are the steps that cannot be achieved in such a short time?

Certainly the construction of infrastructures to support separate waste collection, but also the accompaniment to the change in the culture of all the people involved, which requires the times, methods, steps and sedimentations necessary to fully act on the change.

What would you recommend to a municipality that wants to implement a tourism strategy to promote its territory?

As a first aspect, analyze the identity of the area, who are the public and private entities, what is the history of this area, do an in-depth analysis of the potential.

Then choose what to focus on, not to have too many objectives, because a tourism strategy is a complex thing, it needs time, it needs aggregation of interests of different subjects, public and private. So choose adequately the strategic objectives to align the investments, the choices, to aggregate as much as possible even with a mediumlong-term stakeholders, both public and private.
