INTRODUCTION

This storyboard focuses on the field mission in Lybia, with relevant visits to facilities, infrastructures and meetings with sectoral operators and local authorities, among the pilot project linked to the training component of local economic development, implemented by the Institute of Oceanography and Experimental Geophisics – OGS, on behalf of Friuli Venezia-Giulia Region in the framework of REBUILD project.

- Facts finding mission to better understand on the ground and through targeted field visits and meetings, the challenges to be addressed and the feasibility of the planned interventions;



PILOT PROJECT FISHERY

The pilot project is the follow-up of PATH-DEV, a project managed in 2017-2019 by the Friuli Venezia Giulia autonomous Region and five Libyan coastal municipalities (partners in REBUILD) within the framework of the Nicosia Initiative.

The Fishery pilot action aims at putting at disposal to the local community of the fishery sector and related productive sectors, adequate facilities and qualified expertise to facilitate certification and commercialization of fish at international level.

The pilot action on fishery is implemented in the framework of the REBUILD project in the Libyan municipalities of Sirte, Zliten, Benghazi, Tripoli, Tobruk. It aims at putting at disposal of the fishery sector's local community and related productive sectors a facility for the storage and management of fishery in order to allow its conservation, refrigeration, commercialization, preparation for delivery to customers and delivery (a comprehensive traceability system for the supply chain in the fishery sector).

The management of the pilot project is led by the Friuli Venezia Giulia Autonomous Region, with the technical support of the Italian National Institute of Oceanography and Applied Geophysics (OGS) acting as technical assistance partner.

LEAD BY



Friuli Venezia Giulia, one the 20 Italian Regions, is at the same time noted as one five Italian autonomous Regions with special statute. It is located in the northeast of the country with a population of around 1.2 million people and its capital is Trieste.

The Region, enjoying particular forms and conditions of autonomy, has a strong presence in international projects and affairs. The international cooperation programs and policies that are being developed towards the southern Mediterranean basin are in fact focused on consolidating the role of the Region as the northernmost terminal point of the Mediterranean area.

The previous PATH-DEV project implemented in the years 2017-2019 and the ongoing REBUILD project are an example of the Friuli Venezia Giulia region's global geographical reach.

More specifically, as part of the REBUILD project, the Region acts as the coordinator of a working package dedicated to the pilot action on fishing and is responsible for Libyan fish traceability and certification according to the model of EU regulations, and for implementing training activities for local operators and experts.
