One of the 20 Italian Regions, it is one of the five Italian autonomous Regions with special statute. It is located in the northeast of Italy with a population of around 1.2 million people and its capital is Trieste. The Region has a strong presence in international projects and affairs. The international cooperation programs and policies that are being developed towards the southern Mediterranean basin are in fact focused on consolidating the role of the Region as the northernmost terminal point of the Mediterranean area.

The PATH-DEV project implemented in the years 2017-2019 and the ongoing REBUILD project are examples of the Friuli Venezia Giulia geographical reach within the Mediterranean area.

As part of the REBUILD project, the Region acts as the coordinator of a working package dedicated to the pilot action on fishing and is responsible for Libyan fish traceability and certification according to the model of EU regulations, and for implementing training activities for local operators and experts.

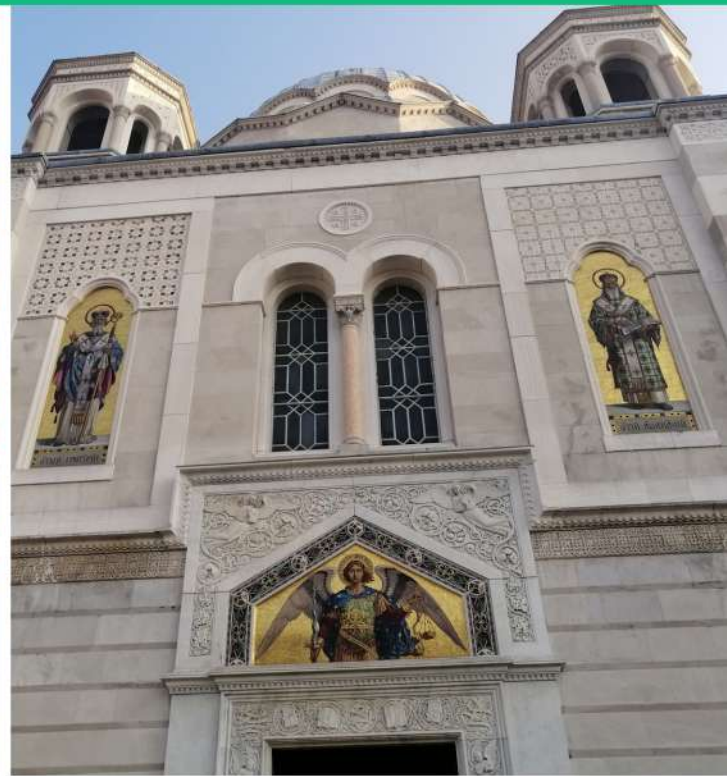
This pilot action on fishery is implemented with the support of the Italian National Institute of Oceanography and Applied Geophysics (OGS).

FINAL DECLARATION

In conclusion of the third meeting of the Steering Committee of the project REBUILD, Research and Education Building Urban Institutions for Local Development, united by the spirit of mutual trust and cooperation, the partners:

- Recognizing the value of the Nicosia initiative which has started eight years ago as process of direct collaboration between European and Libyan local authorities upon the proposal by a delegation of Libyan mayors and under the aegis of the European Committee of the Regions,
- Acknowledging that strategic peer-to-peer partnerships between European local authorities' leaders and Libya's mayors amid Libyan sensitive political transition is a relevant and efficient approach to enhance the quality of Libyan local administrations performances
- Acknowledging that the project REBUILD has appropriately acted in support of the National strategy of Libyan Municipalities' capacity building through consolidating links with the Libyan Center for Municipal Development and Support to Decentralisation that has resulted in the integration of REBUILD training process delivered by Libyan universities
- Reiterating partners' full commitment in continuing and further develop the collaboration within the framework of the REBUILD project
- Recognising the need to adapt the project strategy and activities to a Libyan context which is still transitional and in continuous construction.

The Partners

1. Highlight the importance of further enhancing synergies with other projects and programmes that are implemented by the Libyan authorities and by other international organisations to foster the leading role of local administrations in development processes.
2. Highly praise the commitment of the partnership coordinator, the Provincia autonoma di Trento, to manage the project partnership with a collaborative spirit that implements and sustains dialogue and mutual trust; and share its experience of good governance.

FINAL DECLARATION

3. Highly praise the commitment of partner Municipalities, and especially of the Mayors as their leaders, to facilitate the implementation of the project by:
 - leading the selection of the participants to the training activities and facilitating the logistics needed for the success of the project;
 - fostering continuous dialogue with Libyan Universities and with other entities involved in the project;
 - assuring quality control of the training process by periodically meeting with the Local coordination group to evaluate progress and adjustments;
 - supporting and engaging in the creation of a Community of Practices aimed at sharing experiences, good practices and successful strategies among Libyan territories, also through periodical meetings among the Mayors themselves.
4. Highly praise the commitment of the partner autonomous Region Friuli Venezia Giulia for its valuable support to the fishery pilot project and its commitment in assisting the process to achieve the EU certification for Libyan fish export to European markets.
5. Engage action to implement the second pilot project led by the autonomous Province of Trento on environment protection through reinforcing the capacities of municipal departments of Environmental Safety to improve performances in managing water quality control as per their mandate.
6. Encourage the Project Management Unit to work as proposed in the yearly plans of action prepared and suggested by the Technical Board of the project and discussed and adopted by this Steering Committee.
7. Agree to pave the way forward and take stock of the experience and the relationships built through the implementation of the first edition of the REBUILD project. All partners emphasise the importance of continuing on the path started with REBUILD and agree on the need to identify tools and actions that will enable its continuation. This implies the commitment of all partners to define actions of mutual interest, based on the lessons learnt and coherent with local and national priorities, according to available resources.
