The focus is on the implementation of training activities and coordination meetings.









M.3.2. Risk Management and tools of Project Management

M.3.3. Public policies

Cycle 3 training deals with **project management**, which is a problem-solving technique to facilitate decision making processes. The focus is on how local development processes can be translated into action by a local authority through projects and public policies.

- Projects, from the Latin proiectare, refer to push forward, to build something that does not yet exist, to impact on a situation that one wants to change in the desired direction. It applies to the most diverse spheres of life and it requires the ability to find new solutions to evolving complex needs. Projects can be analysed from 2 points of view: methodological (how activities are organised) and organisational (how to set-up the organisation in order to properly implement the activities).
- Public Policies are expressions of the interaction between actors within a Municipality and a legal framework. The focus in Cycle 3 is on methodology, analysis and evaluation of public policies.

### ■ TOT - Training of Trainers


For the first time since the beginning of the project, the TOT - Training of Trainers of Cycle 3 took place in Libya (Tripoli). This had a positive impact especially because it was possible to organize field visits and meetings with Libyan stakeholders relevant to the project.

### Training of municipalities

Field visits were particularly appreciated, although this might be linked to the topic of Cycle 3. Interactivity and participatory methodologies like group work have increased and this practices will be maintained also in future training activities.

- + Project Cycle Management is a relevant and priority topic
- The selection of participants among municipal officials was not always adequate
- + Training evaluation and self assessment by participants were filled in appropriately
- Many participants complained about the timing of the training (after working hours)














Positive comments on active participation during the training





The Technical Board is in charge of the technical supervision of the project, the definition of the annual work plan and the internal monitoring of the project. It is accountable to the REBUILD Steering Committee.


#### **Participants**

Project Managers and Media Officers of the municipalities; Project Officers and Assistants of the universities; Project Management Unit in Trento (PMU); Liaison Manager; REBUILD coordinator in Libya; Friuli Venezia Giulia Region; National Institute of Oceanography and Applied Geophysics - OGS; Delegation of the European Union to Libya; CIEDEL; Disamis (external evaluators).

#### **Topics**

- Update of the project implementation: while year 1 was devoted to setting the project tools, year 2 focused on the
  implementation of the activities. The project activities (training, summer school, field visits on pilot project 1) were
  implemented according to Plan of Action, despite the problem of the transfer of funds from Italy to Libya. This
  challenge was overcome in spring 2023; afterwards payments payments are regularly implemented.
- Project monitoring and evaluation
- Amendment to the Grant Contract between the Province of Trento and the European Union
- Budget, procedure to subgrant to universities, communication activities, analysis of the Local Development Plan
  of each municipality
- Brainstorming around REBUILD after the conclusion of the project, in 2025.

The Steering Committe is the decision-making body of the REBUILD project. It promotes the institutional framework for the implementation of project activities and the sustainability of the project results.

### **COORDINATION MEETINGS**

### **REBUILD participation in the MDDSC study visit (Kehl, Germany)**

On April 30 - May 1, 2023, one of REBUILD Training Officers participated in a study visit organised by Khel University for trainers and staff of the Municipal Development and Decentralisation Support Centre (MDDSC). The study visit aimed at improving the newly established Libyan national training centre by benchmarking with international Centres. REBUILD blended training approach was presented and discussed as a possible approach to be adopted also beyond the project activities.



#### Online working groups

Regular meetings with all REBUILD partners: meetings attended on average by 20-30 persons, where project is monitored and main issues are discussed among the partners, such as: project M&E and audit, financial issues, subgrant procedure, training activities (Cycles 3 and 4), pilot projects, administrative requirements (6-month partners' reports), project, grant contract amendment

**Meetings on pilot project on environmental safety**: meetings among the five municipalities and MoLG for the finalisation of the project concept note and an operational plan for its implementation.

Meetings among Media Officers: monthly meetings to monitor communication activities carried out, coordinate about the activities planned and discuss the ways of communicating.



### **Fishery Pilot Project**

Within the REBUILD Fishery Pilot Project, in September 2023 the OGS team of experts finalised a report providing a detailed **analysis** across Libya on the fishery ports and markets visited during the **second mission to Libya** (March, 2023). The report contains info-sheets summarising the necessary steps to be undertaken in each inspected sites to achieve EU standards in managing the fishery chain: from the sea to the shop/market. Two sites have been identified for the intervention by the Pilot Action: the fishery port of Zliten and the port of the Turks in Tobruk.

Out of these two candidates, the port of Zliten was chosen as the place where to undertake the on-site works, also considering the need to optimize resources available for the implementation of the intervention.
