INTRODUCTION

Partnerships between territories and actors: this is the main assumption of this summer school.

Exchanges between territories and identification of “relevant practices”: these are the main actions of this Summer School.

The purpose of this important REBUILD activity was to strengthen the **REBUILD Community of Practice** on how territories can address common or similar challenges such as climate/environmental, social/citizenship, democratic/power structure. These crises are interconnected, so in order to effectively address each of them, an integrated approach should be adopted. They are global challenges which are reflected anywhere also at the local level, even if the territories are not impacted to the same extent and on the same timelines. Despite different contexts (institutional, political, experiential), the summer school has been able to find common ground for participants to learn and be inspired from each other.

The second Summer School of the REBUILD project was organized by Ciedel in coordination with the Autonomous Province of Trento, the International Cooperation Centre with the participation of the Municipality of Lyon and the *Métropole de Lyon*. It focused on the following main themes:

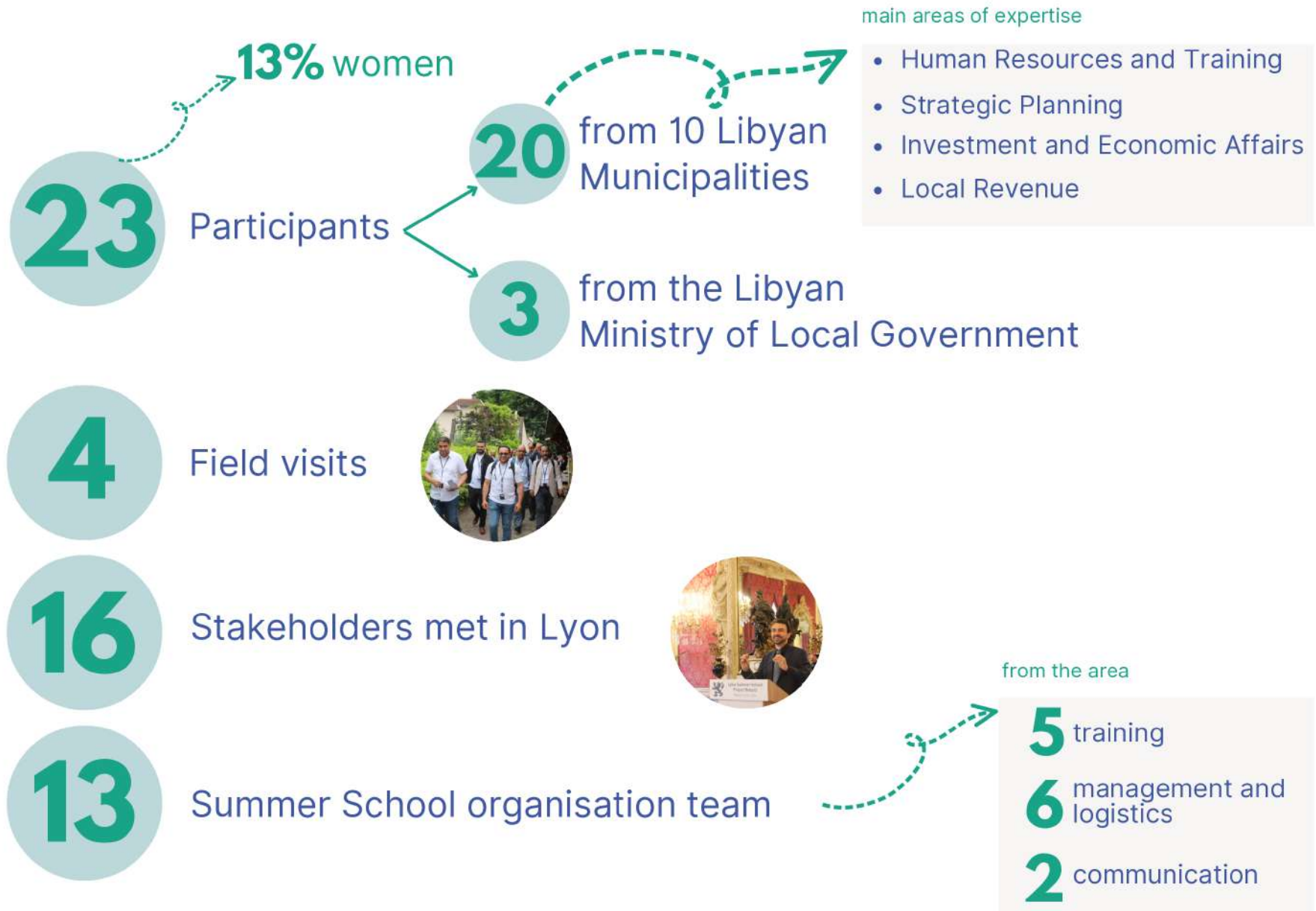
- Local economic development

The methodological approach of the Summer School is based on Participatory Experiential Learning.
