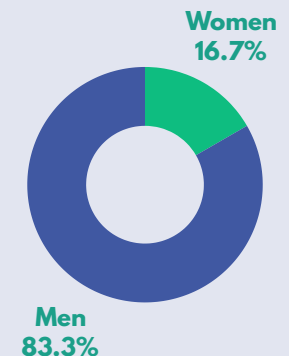
In particular, it deals with the **field mission held from 25 to 31 January 2025 in Zliten (Libya)**.

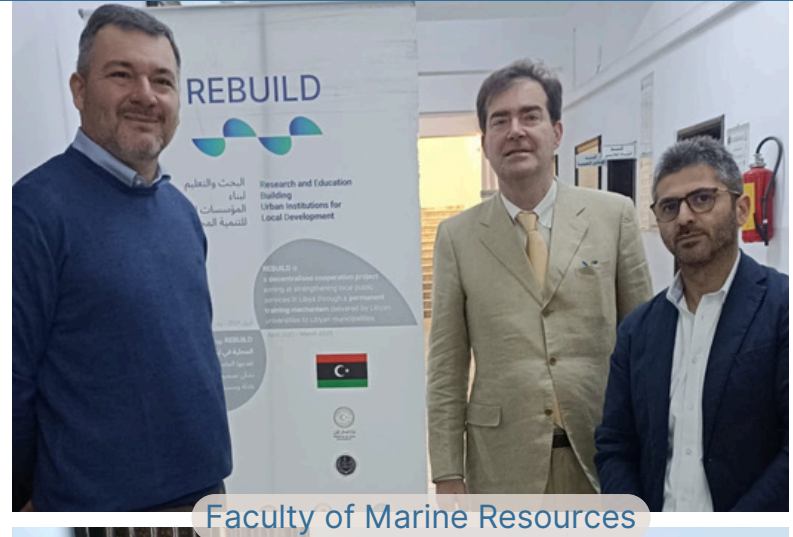

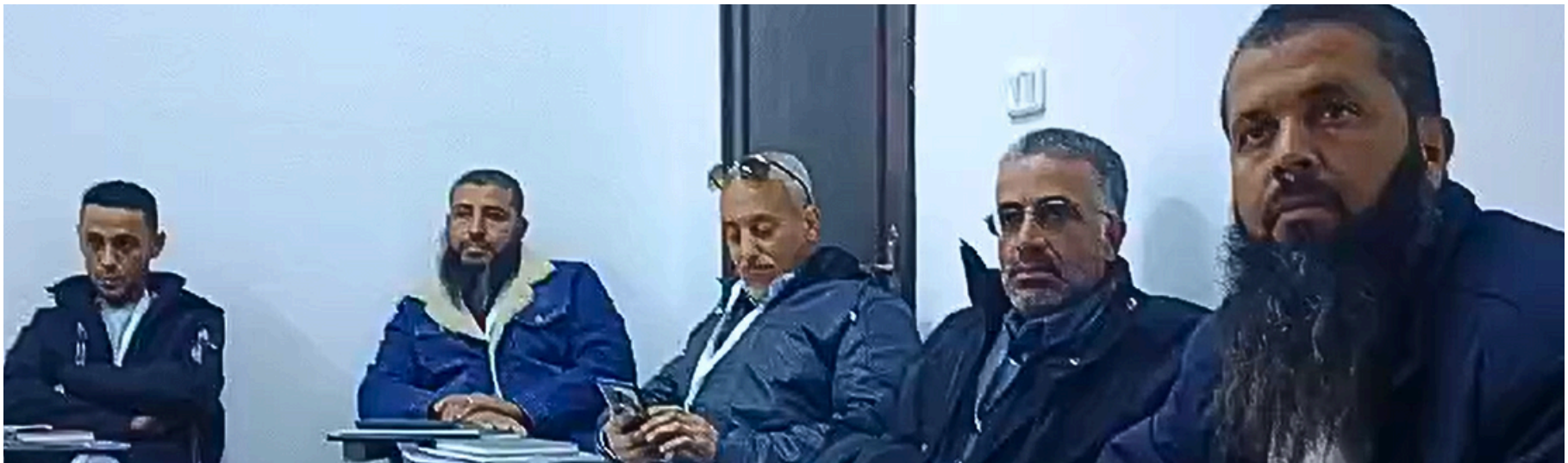

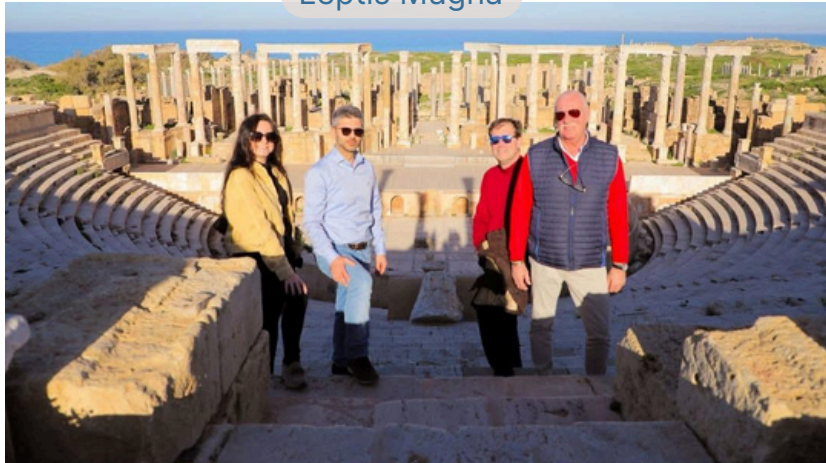

On-site training in Italy for 3 veterinarians (two from Zliten and one from Tobruk)

Trieste and Marano Lagunare

A semester: February - July, 2025

For the full achievement of the objectives, a work experience has been organized for three young Libyan veterinarians at companies in the fisheries and agri-food sectors within the regional territory (in Trieste and in Marano Lagunare).

Zliten , March 25, 2025

The construction of the new facility at the Fishery Port of Zliten is almost completed, and installation of coatings, followed by the technical equipment will be completed by mid-March.

An opening ceremony is foreseen for the 25th of March, 2025.



PILOT FISHERY'S MAIN ACHIEVEMENTS

- Having conducted an in-depth assessment of the fishing situation in the five municipalities involved (Benghazi, Sirte, Tobruk, Tripoli, Zliten), producing ad-hoc information on what needs to be implemented on the sites visited to approach European standards. In fact the decision to invest in Zliten has been the outcome of a SWOT analysis, which has considered, beside the strong commitment of the Mayor and the local municipality, the vitality of the operators (fishermen, processors, university, fishery secondary school, etc.)
- Having witnessed their capacity to work together, with an approach of supply chain and exploit synergies, the closeness to logistics infrastructure (Khoms), the synergic location of the Faculty of Marine Resources, the financial ecosystem ensuring appeal for potential investments
- Having provided an on-the-job training session held in January 2025 in Zliten towards the operators to be employed at the new facility of the Fishery Port, has represented an important step towards the completion of an intervention aimed at "equipping" the Municipality with an effective tool for supporting a development policy for the sector
- Having involved in the training, both in its theoretical and practical sessions, 17 trainees, strongly interested to acquire the necessary elements to operate according to the EU standards
