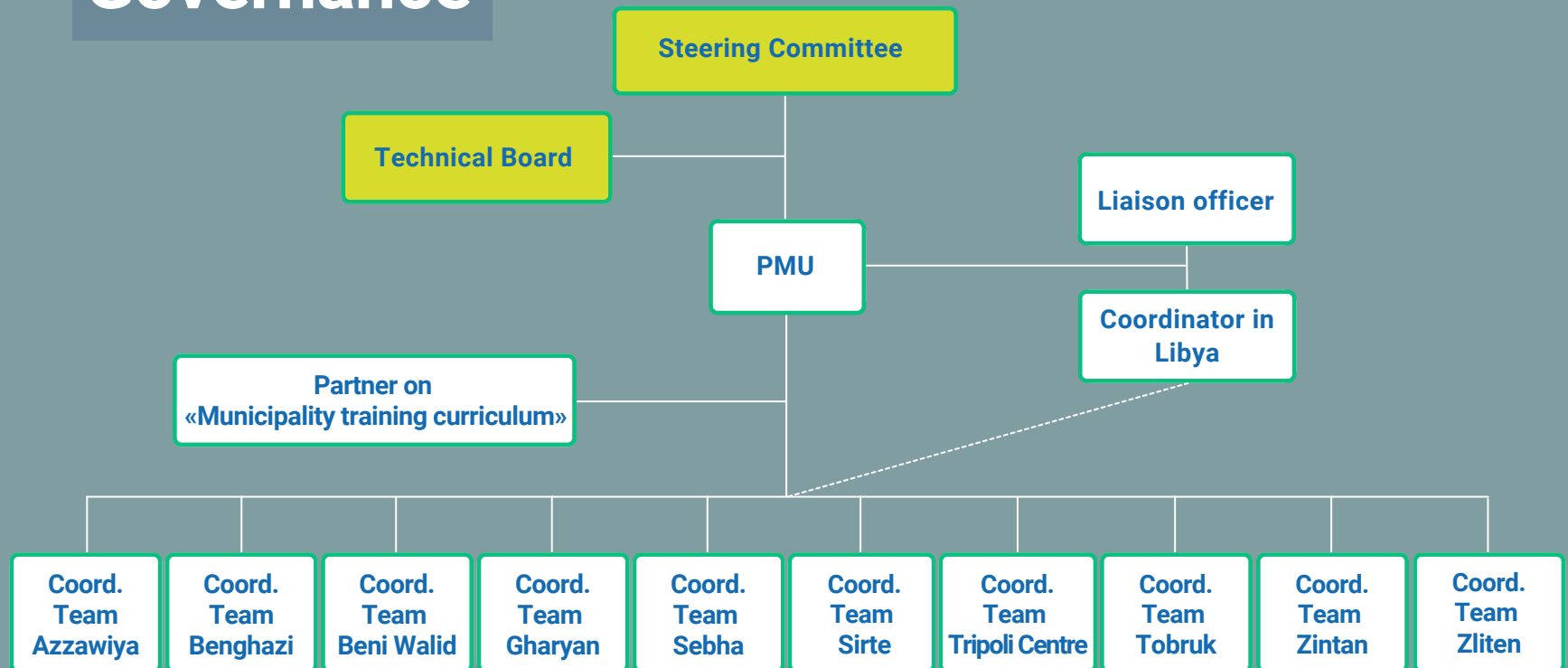

TECHNICAL BOARD

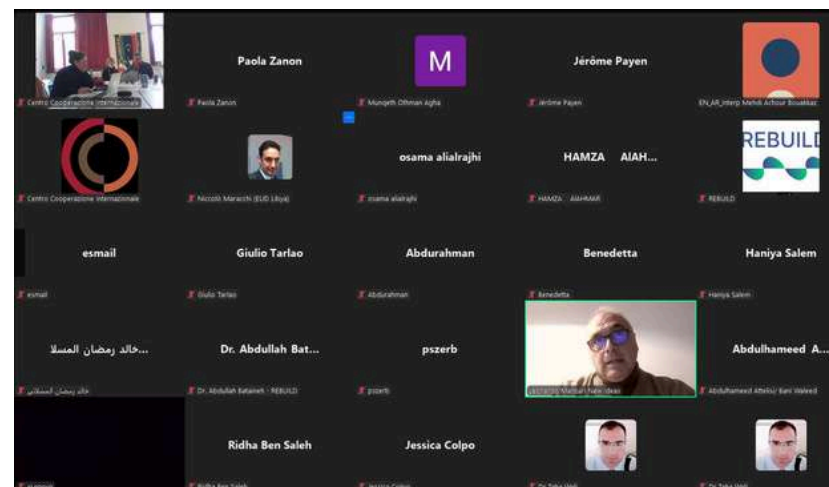
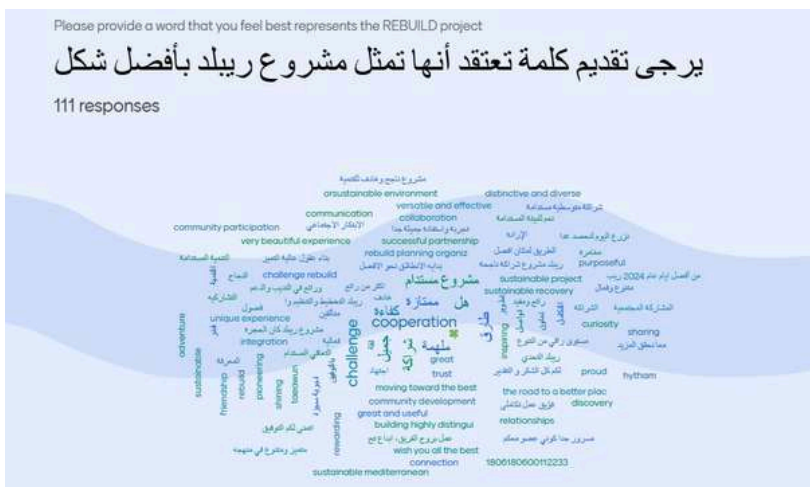
Online, February 20, 2025

Structure

In this Technical Board meeting, the Project Management Unit in Trento presented the updated Plan of Action of Year 4 that was discussed and validated. Municipality Project Managers and University Project Officers presented their perspectives on the main achievements of REBUILD "on the ground", in each municipality and university.

MUNICIPALITIES ACTION TO REBUILD-ING LIBYA

The trailer of a short film has been presented during the Steering Committee meeting. The narrative of this short film emerged from the REBUILD community of practice, specifically from the work with the media officers of ten municipalities during a three-day workshop in Benghazi in April 2024, with the technical support of Libyan filmmakers. This documentary proposes a new approach to storytelling, where local administrations speak about themselves, their challenges, and their commitment in an authentic and engaging way, fostering a stronger connection with citizens and making them active participants in the process of change. Investing in media personnel training is important in strengthening trust between citizens and local administrations. Although this particular film showcases projects from five municipalities due to space and time constraints, it represents all ten municipalities and, more broadly, Libya's decentralization journey.
